Will Sammy be able to find salvation in Jesus Christ before it's too late?



## CHANGE OF PLANS GOD'S WAY: DIRECTOR'S REMARKS



We asked Director Orlando Santos of Providence, RI what drove him to write, direct and produce the film *Change of Plans God's Way*. What does it mean to him personally?

"As a Pastor and father of two I am greatly concerned to see the non-ending media coverage depicting violence among our youth. *Change of Plans God's Way*, along with entertainment value, provides a strong message that lives can be transformed through hope in Jesus Christ.

I wanted to create something that reflects what we are seeing in the streets right now - gangs, drugs - and the violence that goes with that life style. I wanted to show our young

people that no matter what path in life they may have taken, they can find a resolution in Christ. I wanted them to understand that if you put your faith in Jesus into practice miracles can happen and mountains can be moved.

Our main character, Sammy, doesn't believe in Christ. He came from a broken home; his father had abandoned him and he didn't have a normal family life. It was hard for him to understand the importance of living in a Godly home until his grandmother steps in. There are many real kids like Sammy in the streets right now with family members who live by the Word of God. Our message also speaks to them. Don't forsake your son, grandson, nephew, cousin... don't stop praying for them, don't let the things they do in the streets discourage you from fighting the good fight in prayer, because they still need that love and caring," said Santos.

He also directed a message to our youth. "No matter what course you have taken in life, when God has a plan and a mission for you, there is going to be a change. That's where *Change of Plans God's Way* comes into play."

The Dove Foundation (www.dove.org), a rating organization for faith-based films, has called *Change of Plans God's Way* "gritty and realistic". They have awarded their Faith Based Seal to the movie for its "strong redemptive message".

Says Santos; "Since the premiere of the movie in Cleveland, Ohio, last spring, many lives have been impacted by our message. We have experienced the power of prayer, coming together with broken families mourning the loss of a loved one to violence. Others have told us the message initiated re-evaluation of and changes to their life style. We were approached after a successful showing In Nashua, New Hampshire and asked how we could take the movie to places like Colombia, Mexico and Chicago, where violent crime among youth is rampant. Back in Providence we heard the testimony of a young man who wanted nothing to do with God but after seeing *Change of Plans God's Way* was compelled to question his lack of faith.

In August, *Change of Plans God's Way* was an official selection of the Rhode Island International Film Festival. We sold out the 400-seat venue where the movie was screened. The audience reaction was outstanding! Furthermore, we won the Audience Choice Award.

As we move forward; we continue to touch lives everywhere we go. Viewers of all ages, races and religious persuasions will find something to relate to in this movie. Our continued goal is to move you to choose the right path!"

#### Dove Worldview:


